

NOTICE OF RACE

2019 Victorian Laser State & Youth Championship

9th & 10th February 2019



The Organising Authority is the McCrae Yacht Club Inc in conjunction with Victorian Laser Association Inc.

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)
- 1.2 Australian Sailing Special Regulations Part 2 Off the Beach boats shall apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Laser Standard, Laser Radial or Laser 4.7 Classes.
- 2.2 Eligibility for Youth Divisions is the competitor's age as at 31st December 2019 and the Divisions are as follows:

- 2.4 All boats shall be entered and skippered by a current financial member of a District of the ILCA.
- 2.5 Eligible boats may enter online via TryBooking at: <https://www.trybooking.com.au/BAIZX>

3. ENTRY FEE

- 3.1 The entry fee is **\$85** per boat for the Standard and Radial Classes.
- 3.2 The entry is **\$70** for the 4.7 Class.

4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1 All competitors shall complete registration at McCrae Yacht Club between 1000hrs and 1230hrs on the 9th February 2019.
- 4.2 Five races are scheduled.

- 4.4 No warning signal will be made later than 1500hrs on Sunday 10th February.

5. MEASUREMENT

Measurement checks and inspections may be carried out at any time. A Boat notified of inspection shall follow the instructions of the Race Committee.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available at registration and on the Sailor app.

7. REGATTA VENUE

- 7.1 The regatta site is McCrae Yacht Club, Point Nepean Road, McCrae.
- 7.2 The Racing Area will be the waters of Port Phillip in the vicinity of McCrae YC.

8. THE COURSES

Windward/leeward courses will be sailed as detailed in the Sailing Instructions.

9. SCORING SYSTEM

- 9.1 A minimum of three races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 9.2 When fewer than four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of all her race scores.
- 9.3 When four or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of all her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 9.4 All Division prizes will be awarded based on the ranking of competitors in the overall results of the applicable Class.

10. SUPPORT BOATS/COACHES

- 10.1 All coach and support boats shall register before racing commences by completing the form available at registration.
- 10.2 Team managers, Coaches and other support personnel shall stay at least 100 metres from any boat racing from the time of the preparatory signal until all boats have finished, or the Race Committee signals a postponement, general recall, abandonment or when asked to assist by the Race Committee
- 10.3 Each coach/support boat is required to have a working VHF radio tuned into a frequency designated by the Race Committee and be available to act as a rescue boat as directed by the Race Committee if required

11. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data transmission that is not available to all boats.

12. PRIZES

This is a cube event for Open and Youth sailors and cubes will be awarded in accordance with ILCA Rules.

13. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

In participating in an Event, a competitor automatically grants the Organising Authority and the sponsors of the Event, the right in perpetuity, to make, use and show from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or film television and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the competition for the said Event in which the competitor participates and in all material related to the said Event without compensation.

14. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

15. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$5,000,000 (recommended \$10,000,000) per event or the equivalent. All competitors who submit a signed registration form are deemed to have made a declaration that they hold such cover. Competitors may be required to produce evidence of such insurance and any competitor not holding this cover shall withdraw their entry.

16. AMENDMENTS

Any amendments to this Notice of Race shall be posted on the Victorian Laser web-site no later than 2nd February 2019.
